AUTHORITY: § 1, NRS 482.268.

A REGULATION relating to motor vehicles; revising the fee imposed to defray the cost of producing license plates; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

For the issuance of a license plate for a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer by the Department of Motor Vehicles, existing law requires the payment of: (1) a fee of 50 cents which must be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the Fund for Prison Industries; and (2) an additional fee in an amount determined by regulation of the Department which must be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the License Plate Production Account. (NRS 482.268) Existing regulations require a person who applies for such a license plate to pay a fee of 50 cents and an additional fee not to exceed \$5. (NAC 482.295) This regulation sets the additional fee at \$7.

Section 1. NAC 482.295 is hereby amended to read as follows:

482.295 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, pursuant to subsection 1 of NRS 482.268, the Department will charge each person who applies for a license plate for a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer, to defray the cost of producing the license plate:

(a) A fee of 50 cents for deposit with the State Treasurer for credit to the Fund for Prison Industries; and

(b) A fee ~~not to exceed \$5~~ of \$7 for deposit with the State Treasurer for credit to the License Plate Production Account.

2. A person is not required to pay the fees set forth in subsection 1 if the cost of producing the license plate is otherwise charged pursuant to chapter 482 of NRS or any regulations adopted pursuant thereto.
